WIZO (Women's International Zionist Organization) holds a history of unwavering commitment to supporting and advocating for the safety and well-being of women and children globally.

Today, I reach out to you asking for your voice to be heard against violence.

The recent events that took place in Israel on October 7th have left our hearts heavy with sorrow.

Reports of brutal acts of violence, rape, sexual assault, kidnappings, and even murder against women and young girls have shocked our world.

These acts undermine the fundamental principles of human rights.

It is to the best of our knowledge that women held hostage by Hamas are still suffering from continued violence, while no humanitarian organisation was allowed to see them.

The severity of these atrocities leaves us disheartened by the prevailing silence from many international organisations, including UN Women, and women's organisations around the world.

This was the ground for creating the Me Too Unless UR A Jew Petition.

We feel that silence is not appropriate at this time.
